- **Friday, Oct 13** - Last day to [add/drop a course via R'web](#), no W on transcript for drops (after this date you will need to submit an enrollment adjustment form, EAF, to withdraw from a course, you will receive a W on your transcript)
- **Friday, Oct 13 at 12noon** - Last day to submit a [part-time fee waiver](#) if only enrolled in 10 units or less
- **Friday, Oct 20 at 12noon** - Last day to add a course with an [enrollment adjustment form \(EAF\)](#) and permission from the instructor (EAFs will be available starting in week 3 on [MyForms.ucr.edu](#))
