HERE'S WHAT'S GOING ON!



WINTER REGISTRATION IS (ALMOST) HERE!

Winter 2024 registration will run from Nov. 6 – Nov. 30. Registration begins at your initial enrollment appointment, i.e., time ticket. Time tickets are determined based on completed units, so seniors register first, then juniors, etc. You will be able to view your time ticket on Oct. 31. You can find all important registration dates on the UCR Academic Calendar. Be sure to check out the CNAS Advising Registration page as well as the resources listed in this newsletter to be fully prepared for your registration. And don't forget to visit our GUAC advising window for quick, general advising assistance during the busy registration period!

UPCOMING DATES & DEADLINES

- **Thursday, Oct 26** - Winter 2024 Schedule of Classes becomes available
- **Tuesday, Oct 31** - Enrollment appointments are viewable in R'Web.
- **Monday, Nov 13 at 12noon** - Last day to withdraw from a course (\$4 Fee). Enrollment Adjustment Forms are due at NOON.
 - More information about Withdrawals
 - As long as EAF is submitted by deadline and correctly, it will be approved
 - If withdrawing a course will put you below full-time status (less than 12 units) consult with the Financial Aid Office
 - You will receive a W on your transcript
- **Monday, Nov 6- Nov 30** - Continuing undergraduate students register.
- **Wednesday, Dec 6** - "2nd pass" of enrollment begins, 17 unit cap lifted

REGISTRATION REMINDERS:

- Make sure to address any holds you may have that could block your registration. Log in to R'Web to view any holds you may have, their description and who to contact to resolve the hold. Holds can only be cleared by the office that placed the hold.
- If you encounter a prerequisite error, check that you've met the requirements. For assistance, use the Enrollment Request Form
- For corequisite errors, ensure all course components are added correctly before adding.
- Repeating a course for the 2nd time? Wait for 2nd pass enrollment starting 12/6/23 at 9 am.
- For 3rd attempt course enrollment, contact your academic advisor.
