# **FALL 2023 IS DRAWING TO A CLOSE!**

We are approaching the end of Fall quarter, so we wanted to highlight some important deadlines and reminders. Monday, Nov 27 at 12noon is the last day to change the grading basis for a course. You must be in good academic standing to be able to do this. Grades for courses required for your major or that serve as prerequisites for major courses cannot be changed, they must be taken for a letter grade. Friday, December 8th at 4pm is the deadline to withdraw from the term (from all courses). It is essential that you meet with your academic advisor prior to the December 8 deadline if you are considering a term withdrawal so you can better understand the various ramifications this decision may have. All of us in the UAAC are wishing you success over the remaining weeks of fall quarter.
