- **Friday, Jan 19** - Last day to add/drop a course via R'web, no W on transcript for drops (after this date you will need to submit an enrollment adjustment form, EAF, to withdraw from a course, you will receive a W on your transcript)
- **Friday, Jan 19 at 12noon** - Last day to submit a part-time fee waiver if only enrolled in 10 units or less
- **Friday, Jan 26 at 12noon** - Last day to add a course with an enrollment adjustment form (EAF) and permission from the instructor (EAFs will be available starting in week 3 on [MyForms.ucr.edu](http://MyForms.ucr.edu))
