The deadline to apply for spring graduation was March 1, but you can still apply late with the help of your advisor. Seniors! Summer Graduation




Summer Graduates: The summer graduation application becomes available April 1, 2024. You are eligible to participate in the Spring commencement ceremony if you only need 10 units or less to satisfy all degree requirement

- If so, submit your summer graduation application by Apr 8, 2024 after you've registered for your summer classes.
- If you need more than 10 units in summer to graduate, contact your advisor
- If not participating in the Spring Commencement ceremony, you apply for graduation by July 1, 2024

Spring Graduates: you can still apply to graduate. Contact your advisor.

UPCOMING DATES AND DEADLINES

- **Friday, Mar. 15** - Last day of instruction & Last day to withdraw from the quarter (all classes, you will receive Ws)
- **Saturday, Mar. 16 - Friday, Mar. 22** - Finals Week
- **Friday, Mar. 22** - Last day to complete work in order to remove an incomplete grade from the prior quarter
- **Mar. 25-29** - Student Spring Break
- **Monday, April 1** - First day of Spring quarter instruction
- **April 1-8** - Grad apps due for summer grads participating in commencement
