Seniors! Summer Graduation



Summer Graduates: The summer graduation application becomes available April 1, 2024. You are eligible to participate in the Spring commencement ceremony if you only need 10 units or less to satisfy all degree requirement

- If so, submit your summer graduation application by **Apr 8, 2024** after you've registered for your summer classes.
- If you need more than 10 units in summer to graduate, contact your advisor
- If not participating in the Spring Commencement ceremony, you apply for graduation by July 1, 2024

If you miss your Graduation Application deadline.
Contact your advisor.

UPCOMING DATES AND DEADLINES

- **Friday, Apr 12** - Last day to add/drop courses in R'Web (no fee) without a "W" appearing on your transcript.
- **Friday, Apr 12 at 12noon** - Last day to submit a [Part-Time Fee Waiver](#) to get dean approval to enroll in 10 or fewer units and qualify for reduced tuition.
- **Friday, April 19 at 12noon** - Last day to add a course without dean approval (only instructor approval needed, no fee).
- **Friday, April 19** - Last day to withdraw from a course (no fee).
- **Friday, April 19** - Last day to change grading basis (no fee).
