Degree Audit

What is it?


- Main tool used to check for degree requirements/completion
- Shows all college-level coursework

Look out for...

- Green & Blue
- Red
- There shouldn't be any red after you register for your final quarter
- Any issues/concerns, see advisor


Legend



Degree Audit

- The bottom of the audit shows a section titled "Insufficient"

 - *these need to be resolved before you can graduate*

- non-passing grades (D, F, NC)

 these are "final marks"

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Students who will complete their degree in Fall 2024, Winter 2025, or Spring 2025, and Summer 2025 graduates with no more than 15 units to complete in summer
- Summer 2025 graduates who need more than 15 units in the summer must petition for approval to participate, please contact your advisor

WHO IS **NOT**ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

- Summer graduates who need MORE than 15 units to complete their degree and do not petition for approval or their petitions are denied
- · Students completing their degree the following academic year (Fall 2025)

COMMENCEMENT VS. GRADUATION

- Official Graduation is when students complete all their final requirements
- UCR records will show a degree date which confirms that all graduation requirements have been completed.

Graduation Honors

- Recognition at Commencement is based on <u>UNOFFICIAL</u> data from 2024
- **OFFICIAL** GPA cutoffs will be posted in September 2025
- Honors received at Commencement may <u>differ</u>
 from what is noted on your final transcript and diploma
- You will receive an email, if you are eligible for the CNAS honors recognition ceremony





Important Considerations:

- Location. 2025 Commencement is at the Toyota Arena, Ontario, CA.
- Tickets. Maximum guest ticket counts for each ceremony are calculated based on the estimated number of participating graduates and the maximum capacity of Toyota Arena. This information is not currently available. Check the UCR Commencement website for further details in the upcoming months. Guest ticket quantity will be announced in April and is NOT on a first-come, first-served basis. All students who registered via the Intent to Participate form are guaranteed the maximum number of tickets for their ceremony (graduates who register after the deadline are not guaranteed the maximum number of tickets).
- Graduates Parking Lot. Registered graduates will receive one complimentary Graduate Parking Pass for the designated
 graduate parking lot at Toyota Arena. This parking pass is valid for GRADUATES ONLY and will be verified by a parking
 attendant at Toyota Arena.
- Guests Parking Fees. Toyota Arena's 2024 parking rate was \$15 and major credit cards are accepted (cash will not be accepted).


Diploma

Mailed directly to graduate at no cost (8-10 weeks after graduation)

Will not be mailed if there is an outstanding financial balance Resolve any holds that may keep you from getting your diploma Visit registrar.ucr.edu and click on "Guide to Graduation" for more details

Important Notes:

- Ensure personal info is accurate in R'Web; if not make updates ASAP
- Legal documentation required to change your name on the diploma
- Visit https://registrar.ucr.edu/grades-records/information for details
- Official transcripts may be ordered about 4-6 weeks after graduation
- Unofficial transcript showing Degree Award date may be accessed in R'Web



Post-Graduate Work

- If you take courses after graduation, that coursework does not need to be reported to UCR
- Post-graduate work does not impact UCR GPA or record in any way
- If you apply to a graduate program, you typically would be expected to submit transcripts from UCR and any other institutions you have attended

Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

Question #1: If your name has an accent, does the accent appear on the diploma (example: César)?

Answer: No, unfortunately this is not possible on the diplomas.

Question #2: Do concentrations appear on the final transcript?

Answer: Yes, concentrations do appear on the final transcript.

Question #3: Do concentrations appear on the diploma?

Answer: Yes, concentrations do appear on diplomas (in parentheses)

Question #4: Do minors appear on the final transcript?

Answer: Yes, minors do appear on the final transcript.

Question #5: Do minors appear on the diploma? **Answer: No, minors do not appear on diplomas.**

Question #6: Do double majors appear on one diploma?

Answer: Yes, both majors will appear on one diploma for CNAS students.

Question #7: What date appears on the diploma?

Answer: The date that will appear on the diploma is the last day of the quarter per your graduation term.
